5. Parents' name(s), address(es) and contact information
6. Provide test scores, such as your official ACT, SAT, high school transcript and other academic measures. (Please include a copy of each.)
7. List your extracurricular activities
8. List any work/volunteer experience
9. List the names of two references (Include actual reference letters, at most one page each.)
10. Please describe and explain your interest in the construction industry.
11. Any general comments you wish to include?

Personal Essay

Please complete a personal essay (no longer than two pages) on one of the following topics and include it with your application:

- What life experiences have shaped who you are today and what challenges have you overcome in achieving your education (i.e. financial, personal, medical, etc.)?
- Explain why you need financial assistance.
- Describe your academic and career goals and your plans to achieve them.
- Describe an event in which you took a leadership role and what you learned about yourself.
